

Play Worker Job Description

Job Summary: Assist with day-to-day activities of the Club

Work as part of a team to provide high quality play care for children between the ages of 4 & 11 years old, within the framework of the Club's policies and procedures

Line Manager: Play Leader/Deputy

Working relationships: Children attending the Club and their parents/carers

Club management and staff including the committee

School teachers and staff

Registering authorities (Ofsted)

Main duties include:

- Assist with planning, preparing and delivering a wide range of creative and enjoyable play opportunities within a safe and caring environment
- Providing comprehensive care for the children including collecting them from school and delivering them safely to parents or carers
- Setting up and clearing away the play space including moving furniture and play equipment
- Providing breakfast and afternoon snack as appropriate, washing up and ensuring that hygiene, health and safety standards are met
- Administering first aid when necessary
- Consulting with children and involving them in identifying activities they like
- Encouraging parental involvement in the Club
- Facilitating good communication with all members of the organisation, parents, and school
- Undertaking appropriate and relevant training
- Keeping the work environment healthy, safe and secure
- Working within the framework of the Club's policies and procedures
- Attending staff meetings outside of normal working hours
